The work will be done remotely, with occasional meetings happening in BMW Korea's office in Myeongdong, Seoul. There is no workplace assigned in BMW's office.

The work hours can be flexibly arranged by the successful candidate, with a total scope of 10 work hours per week. The compensation is 7,000 KRW/hour.

The initial duration of the contract is 6 months, which can be extended at the end of the period.
