- Open to all nationalities who are currently full-time students in an overseas university outside of Singapore
- Applicants should possess good academic records
- Applicants must have completed a certain number of semesters in their overseas universities at the time of application:
 - Applicants who are in a 3-year bachelor programme must have completed 4 semesters in their study
 - Applicants who are in a 4-year bachelor programme must have completed 6 to 8 semesters of study
 - Applicants who are in a direct Masters programme must have completed 8 to 10 semesters in their study
