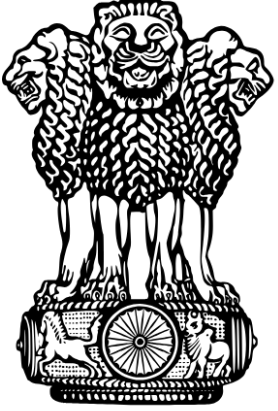

# Funding

## One-week course

- Online teaching – USD 3,500 (~~₩~~ 4.8 Million)

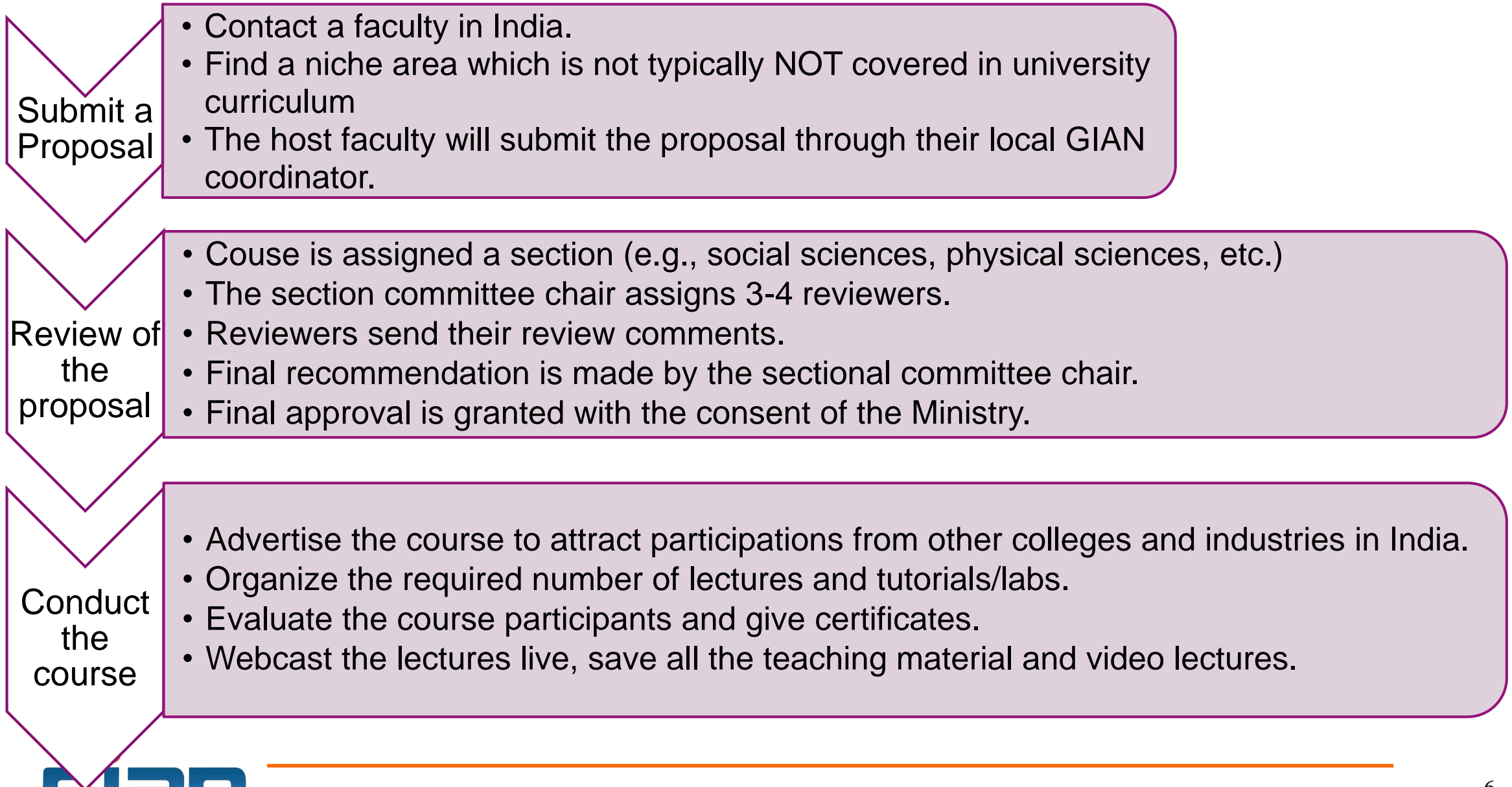
## Two-week course

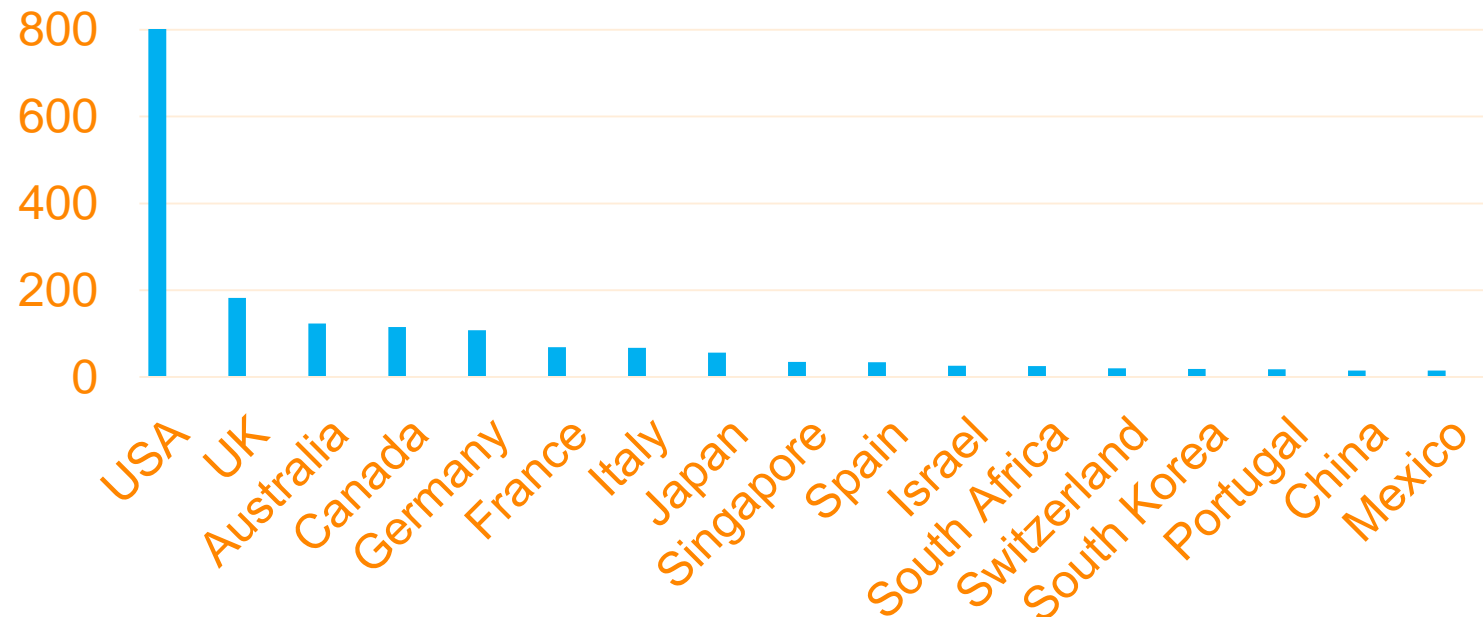

# GIAN Flow Chart



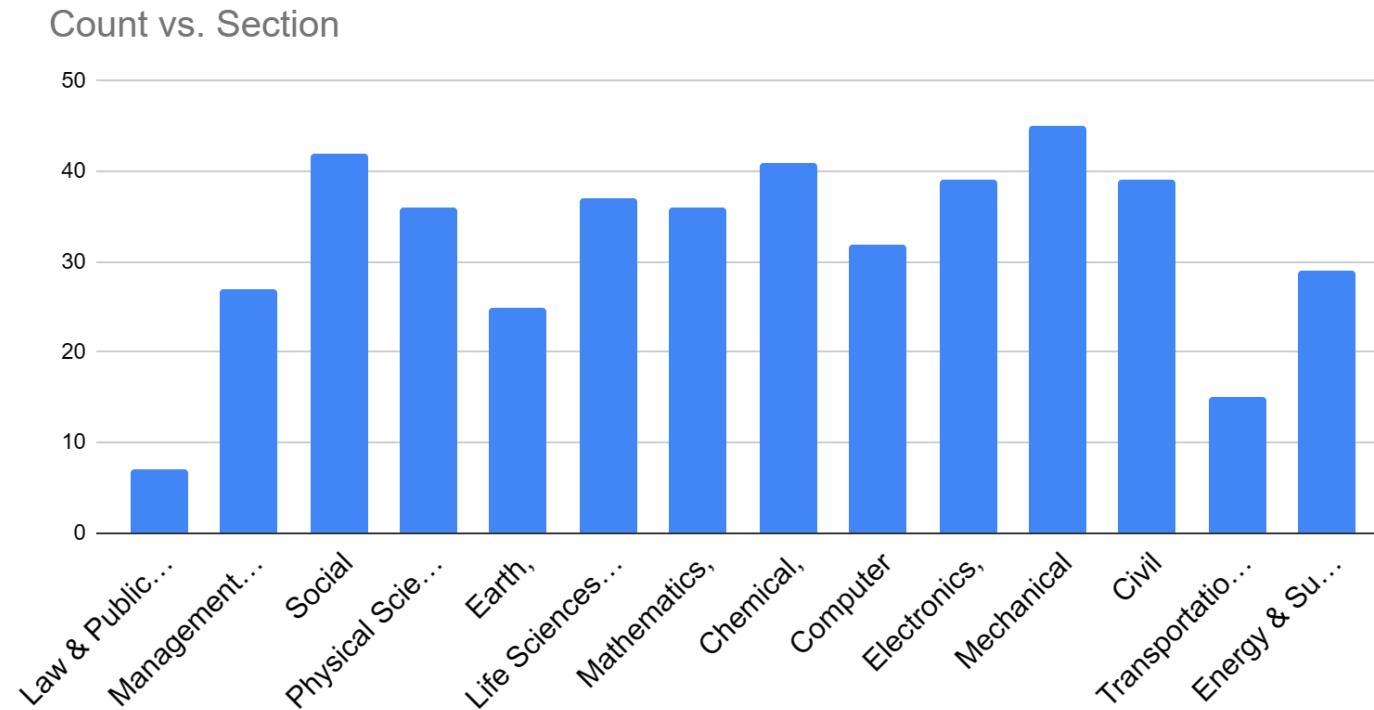
# Past History

- The GIAN program started in 2015.
- Three phases of the program have been completed successfully. Fourth phase has recently started.
- More than 1800 courses have been conducted
- **19 courses** were co-taught by **South Korean** faculty members.
- There is a major potential for increasing Korea's participation.



# Phase - IV

- Invitation for proposal in phase IV is open.
- More than 500 proposals have been received and are under review.
- These courses need to be completed by March 2025.
