<Selection Criteria>

Selection will be based on student's overall academic progress, records of past studies, study plan, personal statement, other achievement records and financial needs by each college.

2. Scholarship Benefits

<Tuition Support>

Recipients of this scholarship will receive full waiver of the tuition fee (except the application fee of KRW 90,000, which must be paid during online application) up to 2 academic years (4 semesters).

The recipient must maintain an average grade point of 3.0/4.3 and above in order to sustain the scholarship.

<Living Support>

Monthly Allowances: at least KRW 500,000/1 Year

※ Please note that the amount of living expenses and the duration of award may vary depending on the individual college/school. Contact details for Scholarship Staff in each College/School will be available after you get the acceptance letter from SNU.

<Accommodation>

Applicants have the option of living on campus at the Gwanak-sa dormitory and Yeongun dormitory. Applications for accommodation should be directed to the relevant dormitory office during the student selection period. Applicants should apply online at the Gwanak-sa homepage at <http://dorm.snu.ac.kr> or the Yeongun dormitory homepage at <http://snudorm.clubmd.net>.

※ Dormitory fees will be charged (not covered by the scholarship).

<Restrictions>
